Hello Dairy Goat Exhibitors!

This year we have a few things to bring to your attention. This year will be our third annual *Doeling Silent Auction* and we very happy to have five donations of doelings from Hoach's Alpines, Blue Moon LaManchas, Vassajara Oberhasli, DRD Nubians and Companeros Saanens.

NEW FOR 2008: For our youth exhibitors there will be a 4-person-per-team Dairy Goat Bowl held at 7:30 p.m. on Friday, May 23. Plan now and sign up at 7:00 p.m. in the ring that night.

POLICIES

Pen Fee: The \$5 pen fee will cover the cost of the pen and post-show clean-up -- *first straw will not be included*. You can pre-order straw at \$6 per bale or you can bring your own. Alfalfa will be available in limited quantities for purchase at the show.

Dogs: No dogs will be allowed *in the barn & show ring area*. Sorry, we love dogs but the goats don't always feel the same way. In past years we have had problems with pet dogs so, unfortunately, all dogs, little or big -- even those on a leash -- will be verboten in the barn. If you must bring them, please keep them penned, tethered or enclosed at your trailer or tent but please keep them out of the barn & ring.

Courtesy: If you are penned in the pens closest to the show ring, please don't use the holding pens. Leave those for others penned farther away. Since there are few holding pens, everyone should make it a habit to bring ropes/chains with clips to tether your animals at ringside.

RETURNING FEATURES

Welcome Table: We will have a table set-up on Friday where show exhibitors can get a free cup of java, tea or hot chocolate, maybe a cup of fresh soup, sign our guest book & leave comments, pick-up REDGA literature and reconnect with friends. Once the food booth opens on Saturday morning, the hot beverages will need to be purchased there.

PEN FEES: \$5 per pen. Fee does **NOT** include first straw but does include clean-up after show. You can pre-order straw -- fill in appropriate space on form. Pens will be assigned on a first come, first served basis as the entries arrive in the mail. Please make a note on your entry form if you would like a particular location. We will try to accommodate your request but there are no guarantees. **TACK PENS** will be assigned if the number of entries allows and space is available. Plan on 3 mature does per pen.

Pens are available after 5 p.m. Friday, May 25. Pre-ordered straw will available after 5 p.m.

Extra hay & straw will be available for sale Friday, Saturday and possibly Sunday.

Costume Contest for Youth Exhibitors

REDGA Show 2008 -- Back by Popular Demand!

Guidelines

Youth must be 19 years old or younger (as of night of contest) to enter. Costume Contest will be held the Saturday night of the REDGA Memorial show.

The goat and the handler should be in costume. Costumes must be comfortable and allow for movement of both the exhibitor and the goat and reflect the class theme. Use no decoration that would frighten other animals. The sky is the limit, use your imagination and have fun!

Each contestant will be allowed only one entry. Non-monetary prizes or ribbons will be awarded for first 3 places in each class.

Costumes will be judged on attractiveness, originality and theme. A live goat must be part of the presentation.

A one to two minute narrative describing the costume must be furnished at time of registering for class. Narrative will be read while exhibitor is parading before judges.

Pre-entering is preferred but not required. Sign-ups will be taken before competition. Please mark your entry on your show entry form. No fee charged for entering. There will be various costume pieces available to borrow for last-minute entries.
