## **POLICIES**

**Pen Fee:** The \$5 pen fee will cover the cost of the pen and post-show clean-up -- *first straw will not be included*. You can pre-order straw at \$7 per bale or you can bring your own.

**Dogs:** No dogs will be allowed *in the barn or the show ring area*. Sorry, we love dogs but the goats don't always feel the same way. In past years we have had problems with pet dogs so, unfortunately, all dogs, little or big -- even those on a leash -- will be verboten in the barn. If you must bring them, please keep them penned, tethered or enclosed at your trailer or tent but please keep them out of the barn & ring.

**Courtesy:** If you are penned in the pens closest to the show ring, please don't use the holding pens. Leave those for others penned farther away. Since there are few holding pens, everyone should make it a habit to bring ropes/chains with clips to tether your animals at ringside.

**NEW Camping Fees:** The fairgrounds has increased their fees for camping at ringside. Please note that the RV hook-up fee is now \$25/night and that camping is now \$25/night.

## **RETURNING FEATURES**

**Welcome Table:** We will have a table set-up on Friday where show exhibitors can get a free cup of java, tea or hot chocolate, maybe a cup of fresh soup and reconnect with friends. Once the food booth opens on Saturday morning, the hot beverages will need to be purchased there.

**PEN FEES:** \$5 per pen. Fee does **NOT** include first straw but does include clean-up after show. You can pre-order straw -- fill in appropriate space on form. Pens will be assigned on a first come, first served basis as the entries arrive in the mail. Please make a note on your entry form if you would like a particular location. We will try to accommodate your request but there are no guarantees. TACK PENS will be assigned if the number of entries allows and space is available. Plan on 3 mature does per pen.

Pens are available after 5 p.m. Friday, May 22. Pre-ordered straw will available after 5 p.m.

Extra hay & straw will be available for sale Friday, Saturday and possibly Sunday.

**LATE FEES: Late fees apply to entries postmarked after May 15 or animals entered the day of the show. If late fees are not paid, animals will not be allowed to compete**

Add \$2 for each doe per show **OR**

Add \$5 for each doe if entered under all 4 judges

**Pen & Entry Fee payments must accompany the entry.**

#### BEST UDDER OF BREED (Specialty Show only)

**YOUTH:** Under 2 judges -- Jean Lucas & Sam Whiteside -- there will be contests for *Best Junior and Senior Does Owned & Shown by the Junior Exhibitor*. No separate entry required. Junior exhibitors must be less than 20 years old on the day of the show. Enter birthday date on entry form. *The animal must be shown by the youth owner unless youth has multiple animals in the ring at the same time.*

Awards provided for breed winners and Best Does. Junior Doe and Senior Doe shows are separately sanctioned for all seven ADGA breeds plus Recorded Grades. No pre-show milk out.

#### OVERNIGHT RV AND TENT CAMPERS:

Full hook-ups (water & electricity) are \$25 per day. Tents with no hook-ups are \$25 per day. *Please reserve ahead of arrival and include with entry fees.*

#### FOOD SERVICE:

REDGA will be hosting a food booth with breakfast at 8 a.m., followed by lunch. Food booth open both Saturday & Sunday.

#### BARBECUE DINNER:

A full service barbecue on Saturday night. Appetizers, drinks, BBQ, salads, and dessert. All delicious. \$9 per adult and \$6 for children 10 & under. Don't forget to order your tickets on the entry form and to invite your friends to join you!

# Costume Contest for Youth Exhibitors

REDGA Show 2009 -- Back by Popular Demand!

## Guidelines

Youth must be 19 years old or younger (as of night of contest) to enter. Costume Contest will be held the Saturday night of the REDGA Memorial show.

The goat and the handler should be in costume. Costumes must be comfortable and allow for movement of both the exhibitor and the goat and reflect the class theme. Use no decoration that would frighten other animals. The sky is the limit, use your imagination and have fun!

Each contestant will be allowed only one entry. Non-monetary prizes or ribbons will be awarded for first 3 places in each class.

Costumes will be judged on attractiveness, originality and theme. A live goat must be part of the presentation.

*A one to two minute narrative describing the costume must be furnished at time of registering for class. Narrative will be read while exhibitor is parading before judges.*

Pre-entering is preferred but not required. Sign-ups will be taken before competition. Please mark your entry on your show entry form. No fee charged for entering. There will be various costume pieces available to borrow for last-minute entries.

- A. Holiday (ex - Santa & reindeer; pilgrim & turkey)
- B. Dress Alike (ex - both ballerinas, matadors, Tootsie Rolls)
- C. Couple (ex - Paul Bunyan & Babe the Blue Ox, President Obama & First Lady, Rocky & Bullwinkle, Tarzan & Jane)
- D. Promoting goat products (ex - a cup of yogurt & spoon, soap & washcloth)
